THINK TANK


THINK TANK is the centralized academic support center for University of Arizona students. We offer a variety of services in math, writing, science, business, language, and academic skills.

Supporting Students via Collaborations

- Library Tech Toolshed prioritizes requests and referrals from THINK TANK and other Student Success units. Students meet with our Academic Coaches and may express high need for technology.
- Collaborate to bring new initiatives to campus. i.e.
 Microsoft/DRC/THINK TANK partnership. Bring technology and resources to support students.
